Altachiara is the mythological sword of Charlemagne carried by the emperors of the Holy Roman Empire at their coronation as a symbol of temporal power. Among them was Otto III of Saxony, who came to Fonterutoli in 998 to establish the jurisdiction of the churches of Arezzo, Fiesole and Siena. Like the imperial sword, this wine of noble origin expresses itself with temperament, power and elegance.
